2020 was a remarkable year in the life of Michel Daher Foundation. The foundation went through an extensive internal work to develop its policies and procedures.



An unprecedented currency collapse, an economic crisis accompanied by the paralysis of the banking sector, and a deathly explosion that left the country shattered and the Lebanese citizens in a miserable state. Adding on top of that, the global crisis of the Covid-19 pandemic.

These events have shaped the path that the foundation would take in the near future, making 2020 a transitional year for Michel Daher Foundation. We rearranged all the work we are doing under four pillars: Health, social service, economic development, and community development and livelihood- to reflect our strategic priorities for the coming years. We also took the decision to focus more on the development of people, seeking to unlock the possibility in each individual and helping them achieve their highest potential.

The family of our foundation is growing, extending opportunities for recruitment, internships, and volunteering. We gained the trust of international and local donors. New partners joined efforts in different projects which enabled us to achieve more of our core mission. The number of beneficiaries increased exponentially. All of that was the outcome of the credibility we gained across the years from the work we do with dedication and the commitment to the greatest impact... 
Promote a healthier community

Michel Daher Foundation's healthcare program is committed to deliver excellence in healthcare by providing accessible, high-quality, and patient-centered services to the Bekaa community.

We provide constant healthcare support to people who do not have medical coverage and ensure the prevention of diseases to all through two well-equipped Health Care Centers in Ferzol and Zahle-Rassieh, where people receive high-quality and immediate support at a low cost, from teams of medical professionals.


In 2020, the program undertook a detailed review of all its services to ensure that it can meet the commitment aims.

8995+ patients benefited from healthcare services



1-YMCA This program aims to provide those in need with 63 different medications free of charge through local health care facilities distributed all over the country. Our beneficiaries also receive access to full medical services provided by physicians, nurses, and health workers through these facilities.


2000+ consultations were provided by a diverse team of medical professionals

The doors of the ferzol health care center are open all over the year to help all women in early detection.






Enhance economic growth and build human capacities with a particular focus on youth and women.

The Economic Development programs work with the youth, women, and SMEs to help them reach their highest potential and enhance their soft and hard skills by providing vocational and technical training in different fields.

The program also encourages entrepreneurship by providing entrepreneurs with training programs to start, improve, and sustain their ideas.

It also supports small and medium enterprises in increasing their productivity and efficiency, strengthening their competitive advantage, and stimulating growth and development.

Lebanese Enterprise Development Program-LED

The Lebanese Enterprise Development project was funded by USAID and implemented by Michel Daher Foundation. Its main aim was upscaling companies in the Bekaa by equipping their human resource with new skills, constantly enhancing the productivity of the companies, upgrading the whole process, raising their competitive advantage, and increasing their potential to grow and create new jobs.

198 beneficiaries from 10 companies and unemployed people received these training topics:

63 participants attended the Peer Mentoring training under FORSA II program

In partnership with Mercy Corps, the program provided mentoring sessions that cover different topics based on the mentees requirements and exchange the knowledge between mentors and mentees to help them find new job opportunities.



70 participants attended Excel training for beginners

In an ongoing effort to expand training opportunities for the Bekaa community to enrich computer skills, young adults aged 18 to 30 years old benefited from the Excel training held at our premises.





45 participants benefited from a webinar about "Entrepreneurship in Crisis"

During the lockdown, Michel Daher Foundation conducted the online webinar "Entrepreneurship in Crises" with Mr. Andre Abi Awad to talk about the opportunities youth can find during the economic situation that Lebanon is facing.

150 young men and women benefited from the Entrepreneurship programs

By year's end, we had armed more than 150 young women and men with the needed skills that enabled them to become successful entrepreneurs.





353 participants benefited from "Maharat min Google"

An online workshop that helped them to hone their digital marketing skills for future job opportunities.

400 individuals took part in the Darb Al Najah program, 130 received grants, and 8 had successful stories to share.

Darb Al Najah is a program with the LIFE project. It is an initiative that is funded by USAID, implemented by Palladium, and organized by three partners: Entrepreneurial Development Foundation (EDF), Michel Daher Foundation (MDF), and Chamber Of Commerce Industry & Agriculture Zahle and Bekaa (CCIAZ).

"Dareb El Najah" initiative supported microenterprises to become self-reliant and contribute to the economic stability of the Bekaa region.





The initiative ended with the launch of "The Hidden Treasures of the Beqaa" booklet, a marketing and exposure tool that was created to help promote the businesses that took part in the program.

40 participant benefited from English Course

The course aim is to increase the participants chances in getting new opportunities by enhancing their English language.

15 participant benefited from Painting Training

The main aim of this program, that was conducted after the 4th of August explosion, was to equip youth with the painting skills to benefit the vulnerable families affected from the blast.





Reverse Environmental and Cultural Degradation

In this program, we engage in raising awareness, implementing campaigns, mobilizing people, encouraging all aspects of voluntary work, and supporting diverse movements to foster the change.

In 2019, "Faker Bi2iyan", an environmental initiative, was launched to spread awareness about pressing environmental issues. In 2020, we created "Green Neighborhoods" campaign for a sustainable environmental neighborhood and

Preserve human dignity by responding to the needs of the Bekaa community

This program provides guidance and support through in-kind donations, medical assistance, psycho-social support and orientation for those who are in need, and works on empowering women of the Bekaa.

1027 cases

received support from this program, including women and children



821 women

attended sessions throughout "Ente Adda" initiative



is a socio-economic impact initiative that aims to support women and enable them to achieve their highest potential and to initiate change in their communities. Extra effort was put into socially supporting 821 women who attended online sessions by providing awareness in different communities and covering psychological topics to end gender inequality, and violence against women, through a series of 10 webinars conducted by passionate professional activist speakers about important empowerment topics.



206 children attended awareness sessions

In partnership with World Vision and under the Qudwa program, Michel Daher Foundation team members were trained to deliver awareness sessions to children on different topics such as child labor, early marriage, gender-based equality, people with disabilities and positive parenting and delivered sessions via Zoom meetings for caregivers in two different areas.
