The Lebanese youth have been overlooked due to the effects of the sweeping economic crisis and the pandemic. Tremendous technological leaps are being made worldwide, but the Lebanese youth are unfortunately left behind.

We decided to be proactive and open the door to the Lebanese youth to be part of the digital revolution by arming them with tech and digital skills.

Besides the tech and digital courses, an incubation center and a co-working space will be inaugurated in Q2 of 2022. This business incubator will offer startups and new ventures access to the resources and coaches they need, all under one roof, enabling them to work with multinational companies while staying in their villages.

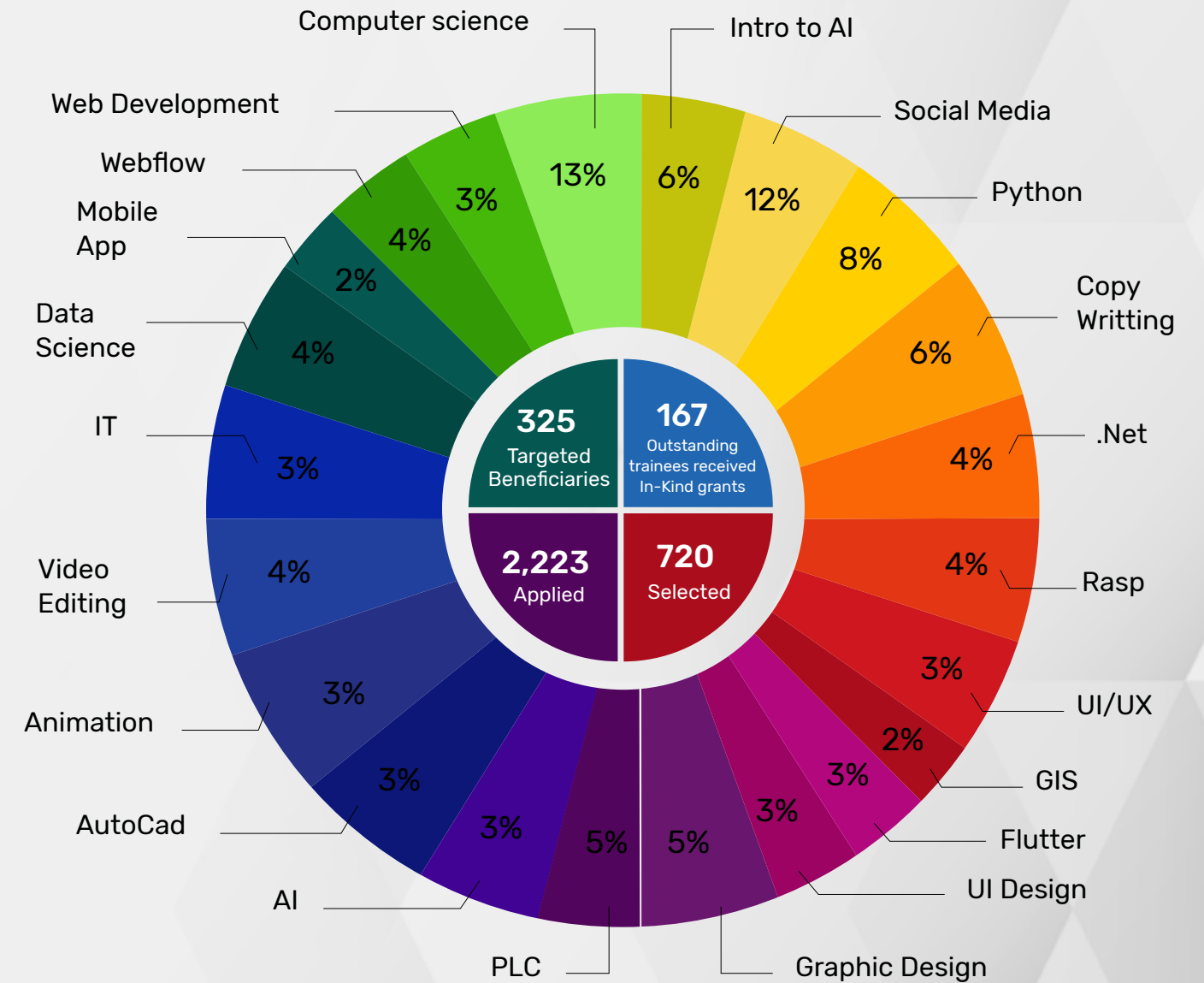

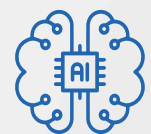

In parallel with the ongoing training, Michel Daher Foundation linked entrepreneurs and SMEs that need mobile apps and websites for their businesses to the tech students.

13 Projects were accomplished and pitched in front of the jury on the 30th of August 2021.



The program manager, Kamal Frenn, launched his start-up "Megabee" at the end of the program, recruiting 30 of the students. Michel Daher Foundation supported Megabee for three months, providing it with all the needed tools to succeed.

The potential that we sensed in the youth of Lebanon made us scout the opportunities to provide them with an innovative training plan.

For that, we signed a three-year contract with Coursera, an online education platform that serves over 20 million registered learners. Michel Daher Foundation opened the way for the youth in the Bekaa to become leaders in the Tech and Digital fields.

Over 333+ earned scholarships The beneficiaries got the chance to specialize in the tech and digital field, mainly Artificial Intelligence and Data Science.

>>> GIL Program

Through the “Generation of Innovation Leaders (GIL)” program, Michel Daher Foundation was an outreach partner with Injaz Lebanon to help young women and men with the needed skills that enabled them to become successful entrepreneurs by developing their ideas, starting their businesses, and generating income.

>>> Cleanergy Program

The Cleanergy-Ideathon program is supported by the Kingdom of The Netherlands and implemented by Michel Daher Foundation to elaborate the first phase in the process by sourcing the top startup’s ideas with cleantech innovations. Top teams had the chance to register in the Accelerator program with Agrytech.



>> Promoting Sustainable Livelihoods Project LED by RMF, & funded by USAID

Promoting Sustainable Livelihood-PSL is a 5 year USAID project led by RMF and implemented by a consortium joining local and international partners, including the Michel Daher Foundation, the Association for Forest Development and Conservation, the Maronite Foundation in the World, Order of Lebanese Maronite, Atayeb Al Rif Cooperative, No Garlic No Onions, and Keylime.

The PSL project aims to improve the livelihoods of 31,500 households across 105 municipalities in North, Bekaa, South, and Mount Lebanon areas through training, technical assistance, infrastructure rehabilitation, and market access.

The interventions of PSL activity will be implemented through the provision of in-kind grants to municipalities, local associations, cooperatives, businesses, and other potential stakeholders based on the PSL methodology. Around 60 grant packages (as the first phase of PSL) will be designed to provide solutions across multiple entities at the cluster level and/or municipality/stakeholder level and encourage sustainability.

MDF will be contributing to the community assessments where tourism, industries, agriculture, and light industry will be evaluated at the pre-selected clusters of municipalities to identify possible interventions that will enhance the livelihoods of the local community residents. MDF will also be supervising the implementation in the Bekaa area.



>>> Technical Training: House Electricity and Air Conditioning Training

In 2021, and due to the significant gaps between the technical school education systems and the job market, Michel Daher Foundation, in collaboration with IECD, trained 24 youth on technical skills to be able to work in electricity and Air conditioning repairing.

We connected the students of this training program to a social initiative by selecting five vulnerable households to fix and repair their electricity.

Adira was launched in 2021 with the mission to reach out to these women, empower them with the necessary support to adjust their products, and unify them under one brand. That will reach the Lebanese diaspora who are eager to taste high-quality Lebanese Mouneh and enjoy traditional crafts through collaborations with international distributors.

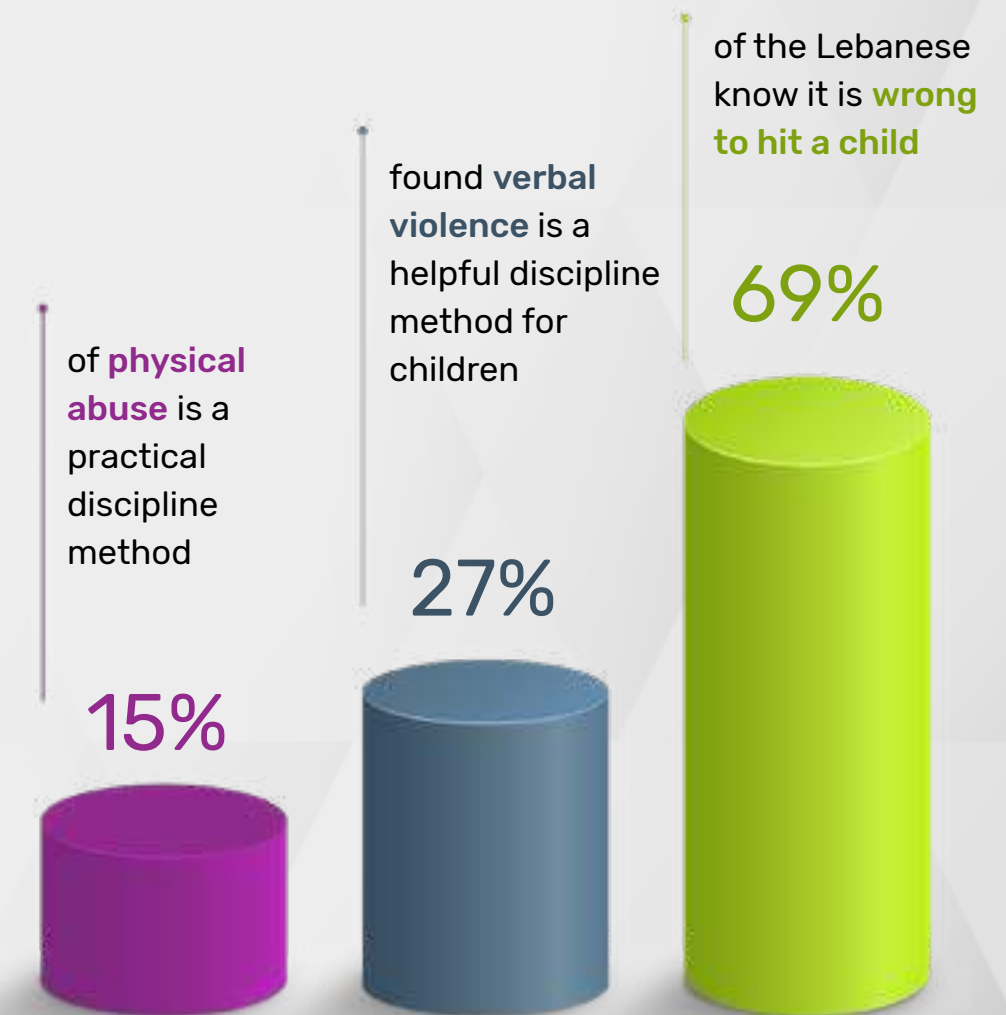

The pandemic, the online schooling, job losses, financial insecurity, and instability had a significant toll on kids and their families. Kids are facing difficulties to engage with others and integrate in the society, spending more time on the screens and undergoing upscaling abuse and home violence.

During the summer of 2021, Michel Daher Foundation scaled up its interventions by developing and implementing the "Antami" program. This program aims to strengthen the sense of belonging and become good citizens able to express themselves, recognize and reject abuse, seek help once needed, and ensure that all of them receive the psychosocial support they need in these dire times.

In collaboration with Himaya, many activities were developed using music, puppet shows, planting as a tool to speak, listen and think freely.

It is provided in an interactive way where kids build their self-confidence while sharing stories and engaging in fun and creative workshops.

With free medical campaigns in collaboration with outstanding doctors, Bayt AL Ahel is an ongoing housewarming center that reaches children and youth through activities. It enabled them to study and implement projects in their village, and as for families, women, and elders opened for them an opportunity to socialize, learn and access medical services.

Skilled and dedicated volunteers never hesitated to sacrifice their time and energy to benefit the community in Niha.

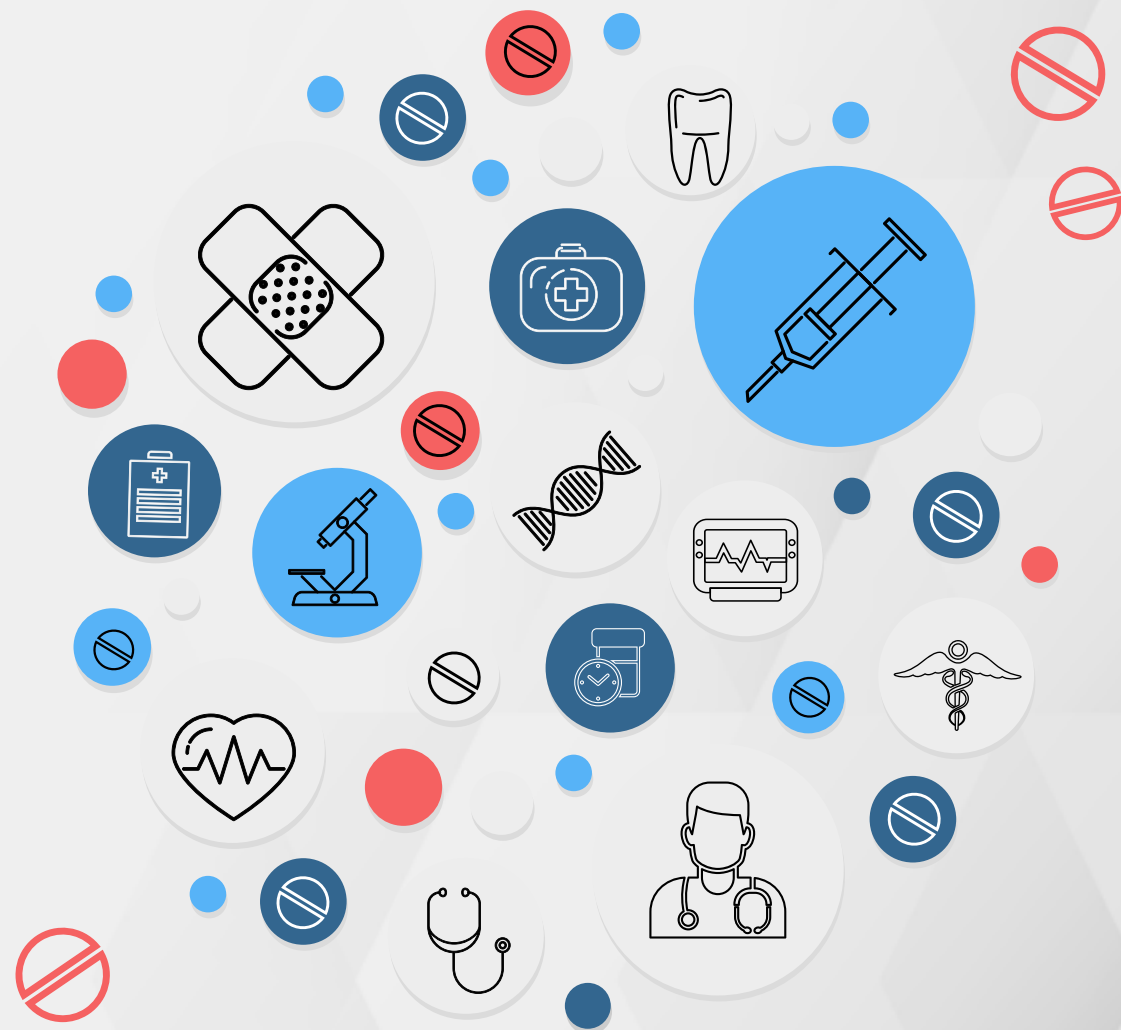

***YMCA** This program aims to provide those in need with 63 different medications free of charge at a very low cost through local health care facilities distributed all over the country. Our beneficiaries also receive access to various medical services provided by physicians, nurses, and health workers through these facilities.

Michel Daher Foundation launched a series of campaigns to raise regular awareness in the community:

>>> Heart Attack Prevention campaign



Targeting people **between 18 and 60** years old. Through this campaign, **26 benefitted** and got medical consultation, **10 were detected** to have a chronic case.



>>> Breast Cancer Campaign

Aiming to raise awareness, promote routine screenings and encourage women to do the mammography test at the Ferzol Health Care Center. In addition, we work on social media campaigns that promote breast cancer prevention.

As part of Michel Daher Foundation’s dedication to save the environment, “Faker Bi2iyan” initiative aims to raise environmental awareness, implement clean-up campaigns, mobilize the youth to become green ambassadors, encourage all aspects of voluntary works to spread the culture of sorting from source, and support diverse movements to foster change. We also organize hiking trips to strengthen ecotourism and enhance the love of nature.

As part of the COVID-19 campaign, Faker Bi2iyan initiative has organized a series of online webinars during the first quarter of 2021. The webinars tackled the below environmental topics:

- > **World environmental day with Dr. Najat Aoun Saliba**, an atmospheric chemist at the American University of Beirut - A webinar that discussed the Beirut chemical explosion’s effects on air pollution.
- > **“Stay Home” webinars:** 5 webinars prepared by our amazing volunteers to share different topics during the lockdown and spend valuable time and learn new things.
- > **Think outside The trash ... Reuse :** 3 webinars with 3 Experts from Lebanon to learn from their own experiences about reusing plastic, glass, cans, and cork into valuable items.

As a compensation for communities committed to recycling, “Faker Bi2iyan” initiative created two “Green Neighborhoods” in Ferzol and Zahle, where the neighbors decided the kind of project they want as a reward to differentiate their area and encourage other communities to follow.

During 2021, after initiating “ **فروز بيتك وساعد غيرك** ” project, “Faker Bi2iyan” implement different campaigns for a sustainable environmental neighborhood aiming to spread awareness, alert the youth of the dangers of a polluted space, and the necessity of recycling. These campaigns took place in many areas in the Bekaa, from Terbol reaching Zahle, Ferzol, Riyak, Niha, Riit ...

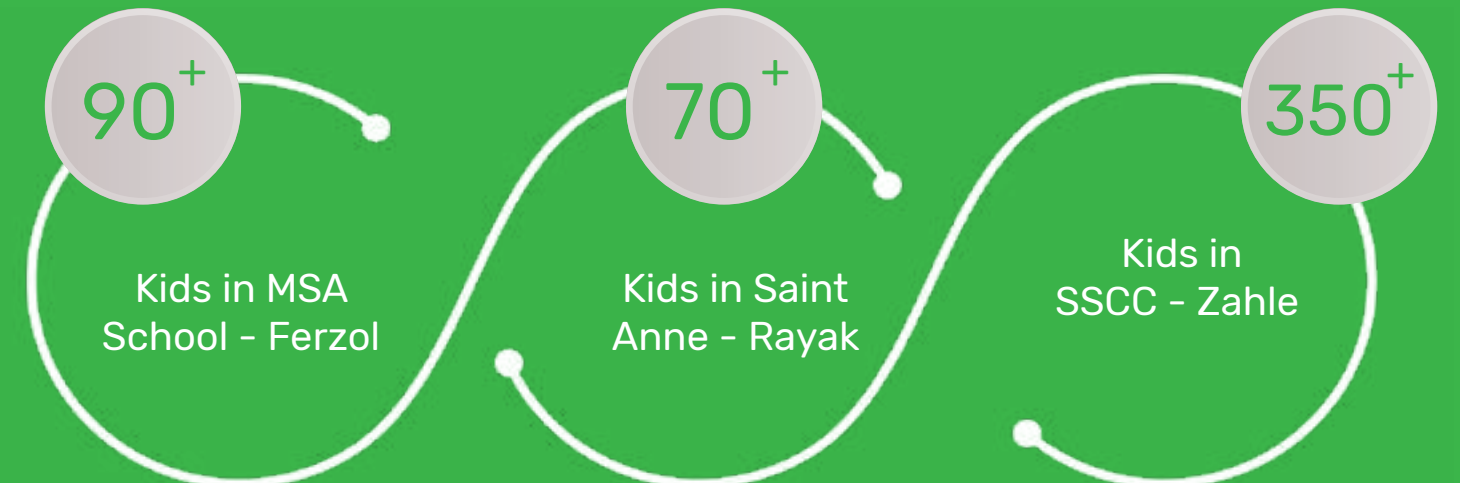

During the COVID-19 wave of 2021, our hearts felt the despair of fearful citizens facing a new unknown virus. In April, with a fund from MP Michel Daher, Michel Daher Foundation launched the COVID-19 vaccination campaign in close collaboration with Elias Hrawi Hospital- Zahle through liaising with the Ministry of Public Health (MoPH).

The campaign reached more than 10,000 citizens, focusing on the neediest and most vulnerable, people with direct contact with others and people with challenging health circumstances.

We successfully contributed to achieving herd immunity, sustaining a healthy and hopefully virus-free area.

As part of the foundation's response plan to the outbreak of the CoronaVirus in Lebanon, Michel Daher Foundation launched, with a fund from MP Michel Daher, successive PCR campaigns to detect and track Covid-19 cases all over the Bekaa region. Around 1,200 benefited from PCR tests during 2020 and 2021.

Furthermore, the foundation worked on an awareness campaign via social media networks to spread wisdom about the virus in addition to mental and physical support to help face it safely.



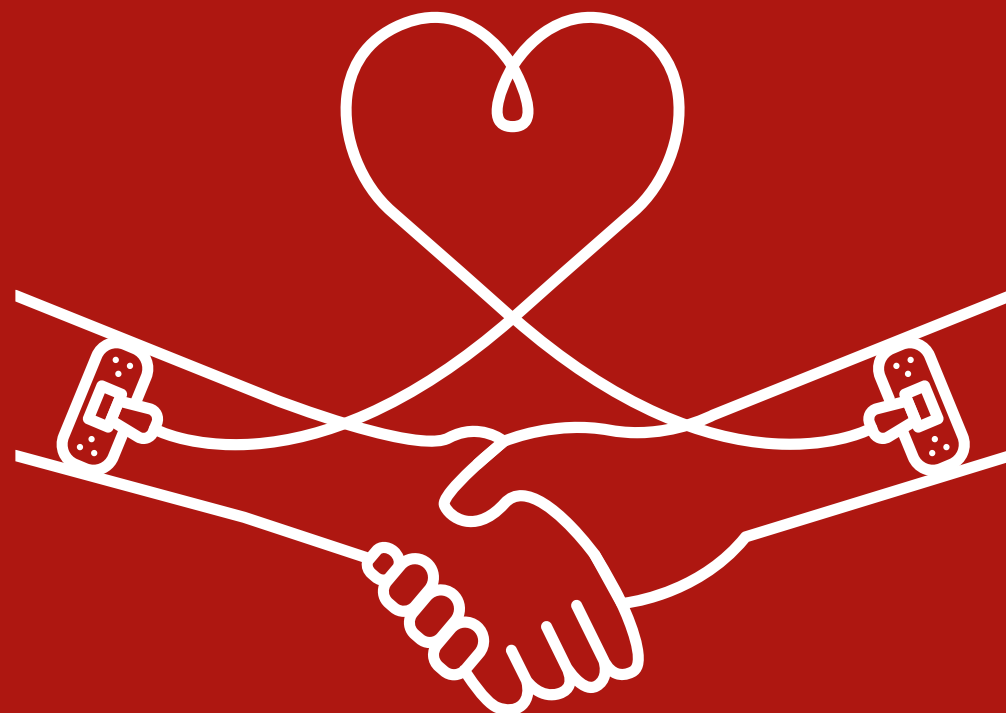
>>> Blood Donation Campaign
